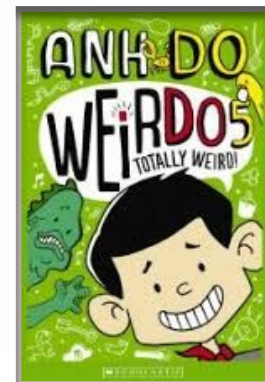
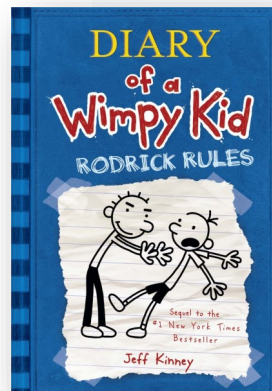
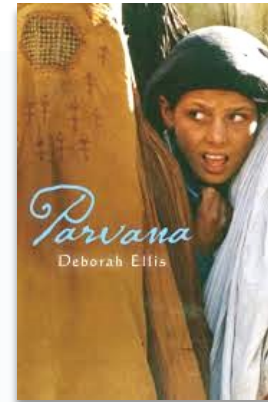
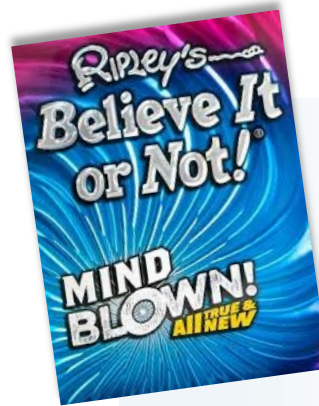


OPENING TIMES

What 's in the Library and Resource Centre for students?

The Library and Resource Centre contains many items for you to borrow.

- ♦ Junior fiction titles
- ♦ Senior fiction titles (for Grade 9 + 10 students only)
- ♦ Small collection of Picture books
- ♦ Non-fiction titles
- ♦ Anime and graphic novels
- ♦ Magazines

All of the above items can be borrowed for a period of 2 weeks.

- ♦ Desktop computers. These computers are available for use before school and at lunchtimes when library is supervised by a duty teacher.
- ♦ Board Games and cards

Please take the time to check the NEW BOOK stand as new titles are being added to the collection on a monthly basis.

Library Staff can assist with?

- ♦ Finding reading material which captures your interests.
- ♦ Finding items to assist you with your projects and assignment work.
- ♦ **Borrowing items**—up to 8 items can be borrowed at a time for a period of 2 weeks.
- ♦ **Overdue/Late items**—if your book is overdue/late please call by the library and return it or renew it. Core teachers will receive an updated list of overdue items each fortnight.
- ♦ **Student ID cards** for Grade 9 and 10 students at a cost of \$2.00
- ♦ Student printer cards - first card is issued at the beginning of Grade 7
